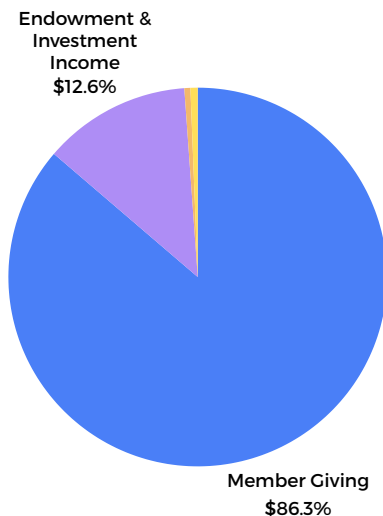

HOW WE FUND THE WORK

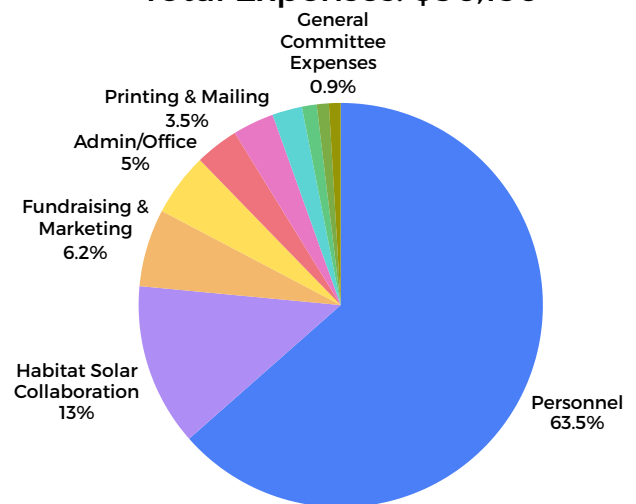
Total Revenue: \$97,156
